

The Compact Chain Tool

Facilitates shortening or lengthening bracket chain Compact Chain Tool, p/n VCT-5 — \$ 21.00 each (Chain not included)



Instructions

To Separate Chain:

Choose a link of chain at least a few links away from the extension end and place it into the primary cradle of the tool. Then turn the handle to force the rivet out the backside of the chain. The rivet will hold in the chain and not fall out.

To Assemble Chain:

Place the chain link into the primary cradle of the tool and turn the handle to press the rivet into the chain. When assembled, an equal amount of rivet should be showing on each side of the chain.

The newly linked chain may seem stiff — gently work it back and forth and it will loosen up.
